Time & elapsed time (nearest five minutes)

- At 4:10 in the afternoon, Mr. Green told Tom they would need an extra hour and a half to finish the work. At what time would they be done?
- How much longer did Tom work than the original plan?

Tuesday was a bustling day at the bus terminal.

- Buses arrived every 30 minutes. The first bus arrived at 7:10 in the morning. At what time will the next bus arrive?
- A bus was scheduled to arrive at the terminal at five minutes past nine in the morning, but it didn't arrive until twenty-five past nine. How long was the delay?
- A bus arrived at 3:45 in the afternoon after a 75-minute journey from its previous stop. When did it leave its previous stop?

Sophia owns a bakery and has many customers to serve each day.

- Sophia arrived at the bakery 15 minutes before it was scheduled to open at 8:00 in the morning. At what time did Sophia arrive at the bakery?
- Her bakery is open from 7:45 in the morning until 6:30 in the evening. How long is her bakery open each day?
- A customer was supposed to pick up a cake at 11:00 in the morning. The customer called at 10:45 and said they would arrive in 25 minutes. How late was the customer?
